## personal study questions

Titus 2:1-8 *ESV*

1. Why does the application of this passage require that older women and younger women be committed as members of a local church?
2. What might hinder a younger or older woman for being deeply connected into relationships in her own local church?
3. If you are a younger mom, how might you pursue such a relationship with an older, godly woman in your church for counsel and spiritual encouragement?
4. If you are an older mom, how might you pursue such a relationship with a younger Christian woman in your church for counsel and spiritual encouragement?
5. What temptations might an older woman have to become a “slanderer”? What impact would this have upon a church?
6. What does it mean for an older woman to be “reverent in behavior”? How does this influence the whole church?
7. Why do younger women need to be taught how to love their husbands? Give some practical examples of what this might mean?
8. Why do younger women need to be taught how to love their children? Give some practical examples of what this might mean?
9. Why is “working at home” such a priority to God for younger moms? What practical applications might you draw from this instruction?
10. Why is a young moms “working at home” denigrated in our culture? What encouragements do young moms need to resist the cultural norms and to live godly lives?
11. What does it mean for young moms to be “submissive to their own husbands”? What applications might you make from this command? What abuses might be made under the guise of this command?
12. Why does the world rise up in anger over the command for wives to submit to their husbands? What Gospel truths help us to resist the world’s view of life and to exult in God’s command?
13. How might a young mom’s relationship with her husband cause the Word of God to be reviled? Give some specific examples to better understand God’s concern here.
14. If you are an older mom or a younger mom, what one thing is God asking you to do as the result of meditating on Titus 2?
