

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. **Do I need to Pre-Register each week?**

No, you will not need to pre-register each week from home. You enroll your child only once, and then you confirm their spot in the class when you arrive on Sunday morning.

2. **What if I'm bringing a visitor who has not enrolled?**

We will work to accommodate new church visitors and guests of your family! We would just have them fill out an information form, and a blank name tag. Please see Daniel or the scheduled coordinator when you arrive so we can work with you.

3. **Why are we requiring enrollment for Sunday School?**

With so many things being different for our Sunday morning services, we believe this format will help us accommodate as many children as possible while being conscious of our current COVID climate. This we hope will give parents less to think about during the week, and lessen the load of our volunteers. As previously stated, should there be classrooms that are running at high capacity, we will work to expand the classrooms as needs arise. 4. **How long will Sunday School be in this particular format?**

We are not sure at the moment. This will depend on a variety of factors (including, but not limited to) class size, adult service times and format, COVID precautions, etc...

We hope we will be able to have all of our children's programs running without these factors and concerns as soon as possible. However, only the Lord knows and is in control of what tomorrow will bring. What a comforting thought that is!

5. **Will there be options for families who want to worship together?**

Yes! Please feel free to attend the main service. If you are concerned about child disruption, we plan to livestream the service in the gym.

6. **Can I Enroll in person?**

Yes, you can enroll in person on Sunday. Online is preferred because it helps us know how best to serve and anticipate needs. If you have any trouble or need help we would be happy to assist you Sunday morning.
